Submissions are now being solicited for one (1) mentorship award and two (2) scholarships in the memory of Dr. Tony Wong. Dr. Wong was well-known for his passion and commitment to public education, advocacy, outreach, and training of future neuropsychology researchers and practitioners. The purpose of the award is to honor individuals who, through their actions, have carried on the legacy of Tony Wong and the mission of the NAN Foundation, which is to recognize, encourage, and promote public education, advocacy, and research in brain health in culturally diverse communities.

To this end, we would like it to acknowledge individuals:

- 1) Who have demonstrated exceptional mentorship to students and early-career neuropsychologists and/or,
  - 2) Who, by their actions, presentations, or publications, have increased public awareness of brain health and challenges thereto and/or,
  - 3) Who have promoted increased understanding of cultural and individual diversity as it applies to diagnosis, treatment, and research in neuropsychology and/or,
  - 4) Who have provided public education of brain injury prevention and treatment, and/or
  - 5) Who have advocated on behalf of the profession to promote the development of policies and standards for the promotion of neuropsychological health.

- **The recipient of the mentorship award will receive a commemorate plaque in honor of his/her service to students, which will be presented at the Annual Conference.**
  - **The recipient of the pre-doctoral student scholarship will receive \$500.**
  - **The recipient of the post-doctoral / early career scholarship (within 5 years of graduation) will receive \$500.**
